this book discusses the evolution of state governance of islam and the nature and forms of local muslims rediscovery of their muslimness across post communist eurasia it examines the effects on the islamic scene of the political and ideological divergence of central and south eastern europe from russia and most of the caucasus and central asia of particular interest are the implications of the proliferation of new global interpretations of islam and their relationship with existing traditional islamic beliefs and practices the contributions in this book address these
